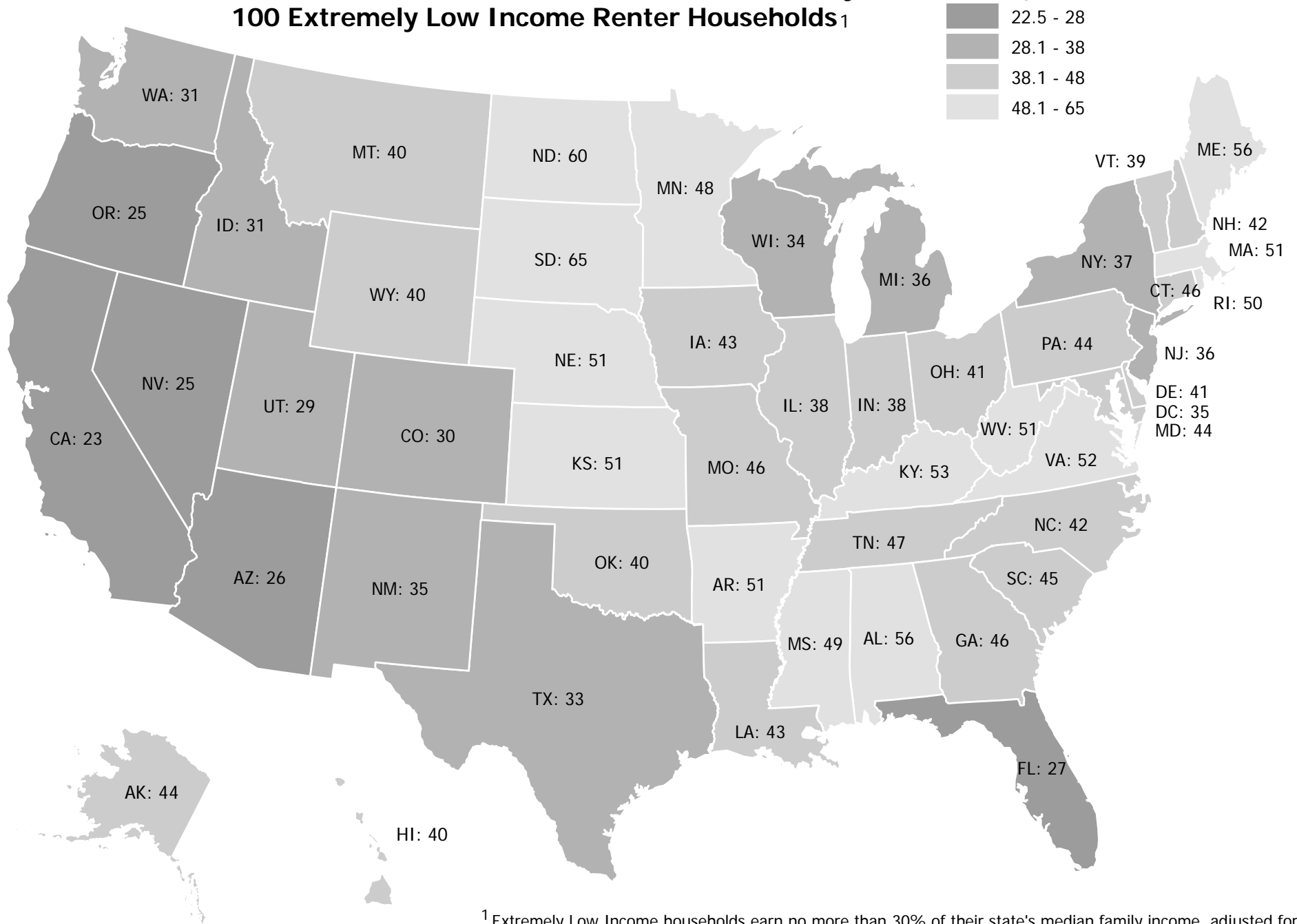


Homes Affordable and Available for Rent for Every 100 Extremely Low Income Renter Households¹
